



# AFTERCARE

## Small Tattoos

1. It is important to keep the treated area clean to help prevent infection and ensure proper healing. Keep the bandage on for **2 to 3** hours after the procedure is done.
2. In a clean environment, remove the bandage and wash your tattoo with antibacterial soap.
3. Use clean paper towels to gently dry your tattoo. Immediately apply a small amount of Griffin Salve ointment.
4. Repeat **three times** a day for the first **three days**.
5. On the **fourth day** switch from Griffin to a standard unscented lotion. Apply generously throughout the day.
6. Continue using lotion for up to **two weeks** after your procedure.
7. Absolutely no sun exposure or water submersion for **10 days**. Sun exposure can cause the pigment to fade or become discolored.
8. Avoid picking or scratching: Do not pick or scratch at the treated area, as this can lead to infection and may cause the pigment to fade or become uneven.
9. Avoid strenuous activities for **five days**. Avoid activities that may cause sweating or irritation to the treated area. This includes regular exercise.

## Large Tattoos

1. Follow the same directions as Small Tattoos with this one addition.
2. For the **first three nights only**. Wash your tattoo as directed above, reapply bandage, and wear overnight.
3. In the morning remove the bandage and let the tattoo air out. Repeat the process at bedtime.
